

ICC Unveils the 2024 IPC and 2024 IMC

The International Code Council has announced the release of the 2024 International Plumbing Code (IPC) and the 2024 International Mechanical Code (IMC) from the forthcoming 2024 editions of the International Codes® (I-Codes). The 2024 IPC and IMC will be the first codes among the 2024 I-Codes to undergo substantial formatting changes to improve the user experience and better align print and PDF versions of the I-Codes with the Code Council's Digital Codes[®] content.

Some of the updates to the 2024 IPC include the following:

- Provisions added for support of buried piping beneath buildings where expansive soil conditions exist.
- Option added for vacuum testing of drain, waste, and vent (DWV) piping.
- Showerhead flow limited to 2.0 gallons per minute (gpm) with performance complying with high-efficiency requirements.

 Standards added for chemical waste piping and fitting materials.

Ohio Board of Building Standards Adopts 2024 Ohio Building Code

The Ohio Board of Building Standards (OBBS), at its August 11, 2023, meeting, adopted the new 2024 Ohio Building Code (OBC), Mechanical Code (OMC) and the Ohio Plumbing Code (OPC) as part of its ongoing process to update Ohio's current building codes and to comply with legislation that reduces restrictive, duplicative or outdated and unnecessary language within the Ohio Administrative Code. has been working with the OBBS as a stakeholder, providing comments, feedback, and information to the Board on the proposed changes to the agency rules. The new code adopts by reference the 2021 edition of the International Codes published by the International Code Council (ICC).

The new 2024 Ohio Building Code will take effect beginning March 1, 2024, providing Ohio's design professionals with reasonable time to incorporate the changes in projects under design. While there are differences between the 2021 IBC and the new 2024 OBC, designers can use the 2021 IBC as a guide to the new rules. For the specific changes in each of the three codes, OBC, OMC and OPC, members can view the changes to the IBC version by clicking the following links:

The rules listed in the above links only indicate those sections that are being amended, deleted or changes from the 2021 IBC.

The complete set of codes are expected to be available through the ICC via both a printed version and electronic version on the website <u>www.iccsafe.org</u> by November 1, 2023. The printed format will be available for sale in a format similar to that currently offered for the existing code.

Ohio BBS Memo - Storm Shelter Moratorium Update

The Board of Building Standards has updated its BBS Memo regarding the moratorium for storm shelters in Group E occupancies to include the following:

December 2022 Update: The moratorium in R.C. 3781.1010 which prohibited the Board's rules from requiring the installation of a storm shelter in any school building operated by a public or private school expired on November 30, 2022. The moratorium also expired for any school building undergoing or about to undergo construction, alteration, repair, or maintenance unless "financing has been secured" prior to November 30, 2022. The Ohio Attorney General issued Opinion 2019-027 in response to the Board's request for guidance on the meaning of "financing has been secured" in R.C. 3781.1010.
