PRESIDENT'S REPORT

John R. Nussbaum, IPP, FASSE, & Anthony D'Ascenzo



I had the privilege of going to Houston, Texas, with Anthony D'Ascenzo (Guardian Plumbing & Heating Inc.) and attend two meetings of significance to the plumbing industry. The first being the Plumbing Contractors of America (PCA) and the second being the Plumbing Council meeting. I was also invited to sit in on the PCA Board of Directors meeting. Attending the PCA educational portion of the conference from Michigan were John and Patrick Jacobs (John M. Jacobs Plumbing & Heating), Anthony D'Ascenzo

(Guardian Plumbing & Heating Inc.), Becky and Bruce Sharp, Jayson Swindell (Bill James Plumbing & Heating), and Rich Gaber (UA Local 98) and myself.

PCA Board of Directors includes staff from MCAA Sean McGuire and John Gentille, Chuck Fell (President), William Erickson (Chair Person), Anthony D'Ascenzo, David J Kruse, Robert Melko, Stan Peters (Executive Director PAMCANI Alliance).

Plumbing Council meeting members include Gary Hamilton (UA), Sean McGuire and Stan Peters (MCAA), Bob Melko (UAC/PHCC), Russ Chaney and Linden Raimer (IAPMO), Tom Gent, Anthony D'Ascenzo and Shannon Corcoran (ASSE) absent.

It was stated that the next UAC Board and Plumbing Council meetings are tentatively set for May 13-16th in Kohler, Wisconsin. Some of what was reported on by Gary Hamilton was that existing buildings' plumbing, mechanical and electrical systems will be 50% of the bulk of work by 2010 growing the service sector. Clean technology will be the next industry revolution. Power is Gold-hello Nuke, Co-Gen, and Energy Revolution. IAPMO, he indicated, was the code of the UA. He also announced that the UA headquarters was moving into a new building in Annapolis, Maryland, in February of 2009. The UA now has a green technology trailer for plumbing display and demonstrations at plumbing industry events across the country. Russ Chaney and Linden Raimer said IAPMO is in the process of writing a green code supplement adaptable to all existing codes to be ready in the beginning of 2010. Council members discussed a joint dedicated marketing and LEED education program for the service and repair portion of the plumbing and mechanical industry to bring existing buildings to a green certification standard. The next PCA and Plumbing Council meetings will be January 22, 2009, at the Chicago Hilton. The World Plumbing Council will meet March 9, 2009, in Frankfurt, Germany.


